### Position Summary

The District of Coldstream is seeking a qualified individual to join the team in the Temporary Labourer 1 – Parks position. This four (4) month position is anticipated to run from late July through November 30, 2024.

Reporting to the Operations Superintendent or Parks Foreman, this position performs a variety of general and specific labour-type duties including the safe and efficient operation of municipal vehicles, small tools and equipment.

### Qualifications

- Completion of Grade 12 or equivalent education and relevant experience
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's Licence and safe driving record
- Ability to complete duties in a safe and efficient manner, following established safety policies and procedures within the district's parks and green spaces.
- Knowledge of safe operating practices and procedures related to hand tools, power tools and small equipment.
- Physical agility and ability to complete duties requiring physical effort
- Ability to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions
- Proficient written and oral communication skills, and the ability to exercise diplomacy, courtesy and tact
- Passionate about the outdoors, parks, and green spaces.

A Class 3 Driver's Licence with air brake endorsement, a Level 1 First-aid Certificate, computer literacy, and traffic control certification is desired. The successful applicant must provide the District with a driving record and criminal record check prior to the commencement of work.

### Additional Information

This is a union position, and relevant provisions of the CUPE Collective Agreement pertain. The normal workday shall consist of a scheduled period of eight (8) hours of work between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:00 pm. The normal work week shall consist of five (5) such consecutive days in a seven (7) day week. The hourly wage is \$28.54 per hour, plus 17.5% of total earnings in lieu of sick time, vacation time, statutory holidays, and benefits.
